“THREADS” QUILT SQUARE GUIDELINES

What do **you** love about your hometown, the Seacoast, and New Hampshire? The beach? The architecture? The restaurants? The people? What or who do you miss most these days? **GET CREATIVE!** Make a square and tell us about it by ~~June 15th~~

Size

Total size is 13 inches by 13 inches; 12” x 12” with an additional ½” seam allowance on all sides.

The seam allowance is like your margin. When the quilt is assembled, the squares will be stitched together along the red lines. Anything outside that line will not be visible.

You do **not** have to mark these lines, just be aware that your design should end there.

Materials

Your quilt square can be made out of any material that can be **washed** and **stitched**. If you don’t sew, you can cut a square from an old t-shirt or pillowcase and decorate it:

- Use fabric markers, fabric paints, or iron-on transfers.
- Use a little bit of permanent fabric glue with soft felt, sequins, pompoms, or yarn.

If you knit, crochet, cross-stitch, needlepoint, or embroider, use that skill to make a square!

Please don’t use: paper, stiff felt, plastic foam, or materials that tear easily.
